Subject: Sites Consultation

Hi,

Apologies for the delay in responding. The PC discussed the 2 proposed sites at our meeting in December but we are only just getting through the holiday backlog.

The two proposed sites in Cropton Parish are 399 and 400 and we would advise you as follows:-

- Because of the Wellhead on High Street access to Site 399 would need to be via Church Lane which would be difficult. Furthermore the junction between Church Lane and High Street has poor visibility and is not considered suitable. To this end the PC object to the proposed site.
- Site 400 lies on the Back Lane to the South East of Greys Farm. The Back Lane is notoriously narrow and winding and any increase in traffic is to be avoided. The site was reviewed by the Planning Inspectorate in 2004 and they stated that there should be no further development or traffic increase on the Back Lane. The situation has not improved and the PC will continue to oppose any further development in this area.
