Dear Sir/Madam

I am concerned about Potential Development Site 424 at Terrington.

North Back Lane in Terrington is a very narrow road without any footways. There is a Primary School on this road. It would increase the traffic and risk of accidents considerably if additional housing built on this road (and the actual building works - involving considerable numbers of large lorries delivering bricks, concrete, tiles, timber etc - would increase the accident risk unjustifiably).

The site is shown as 1.49 hectares. If this were filled with housing the scale of the development would be completely out of character with the existing village.

Terrington is not a Service Village. Only small-scale "infill" should be considered.
