As a resident of Amotherby for the past thirteen years, with three children (one of whom attends the local school) We wish to comment on the above document.

We are very strongly opposed to Site 8.

We have first hand experience of the traffic problems particularly around school opening and closing times.

Speed and sheer volume of traffic when walking with a young child to and from school is unpleasant (due to fumes and noise) and at times frightening with speeding vehicles.

This is compounded by through traffic to neighbouring villages, and to and from existing businesses in the village (BATA and Zetechtics).

Access to site 8

Any plan to access site B would further compound the existing chaos at school drop off and pick up times.

The general appearance/feel of the village would change dramatically with any through the road adjacent to station farm. Any plan to demolish station farm would mean removing a building that adds great character to the village.

Preferred Site 148

This site has the potential to improve Amotherby village.

It would remove the traffic problem, improve safety, and would not spoil the character of the village.

It could also provide parking for the school which would further improve congestion and safety posted by parked cars.

We can not foresee any problem with site 635, and again with access onto B1257, this would remove traffic problems in Amotherby.

We do not agree that site 538 is too far from Amotherby School. Many children travel to the school from neighbouring villages and Malton.
