Afternoon Charlotte

Your email sent on 2nd November 2015 relation to your consultation on the Local Plan Sites was discussed at last nights meeting of Rillington Parish Council.

The view of the council is that if all the proposed development sites go ahead, it could lead to a three fold increase in the number of houses in Rillington. There is a lack of infrastructure to accommodate any further expansion.

The local school is already at capacity. The level of traffic using the A64 will increase in proportion to the number of new properties built. The existing level of traffic already effectively splits the village into two parts, and there is already a long standing need for a by-pass to overcome existing problems caused by heavy traffic. Any increase in the local population will increase this problem.

We are aware that not all the areas highlighted will go ahead, however, it would be helpful if RDC can confirm which areas have been discounted, and those which are still being considered for possible development. Once we are in receipt of this information we will be better placed to provide a more constructive response.
