Subject: Forward Planning

Hi

I am writing to express real concern after having read of the plan for the next 5 years that you are including the Castle Howard road site (north) as well as the south. The planning Committee unanimously rejected the north site and I am wondering what can change to even consider the site again.

My personal view, as a former Town Councillor and Mayor in the 1980's (so I do understand the need for forward planning) is that before any further development takes place in Malton, but particularly off Castle Howard Road is:

1. Put a weight restriction immediately on the A64 thus encouraging so much of the heavy traffic to go on the by-pass into Norton and not through Malton. This was promised at the time of the original application.
2. Traffic problems must be resolved before any more planning applications are considered
3. the work of turning the A64 to York into a dual carriageway should be commenced as soon as possible and a roundabout put at the west end of the by-pass so that it will ease the flow of traffic.
4. The above would facilitate putting a roundabout or slip roads off Castle Howard road where the bridge now is over the A64, thus allowing a free flow of traffic to York, Scarborough and Pickering without having to come into Malton and use Butcher corner.
- 5.. work must be done somehow to improve the flow of traffic through Butcher corner as it is extremely congested and pollution is bad.
