Terrace of 8 cottages, now 4 cottages and attached stable. Early C19 with C20 modernisation and extension into part of former stable building. Whitewashed sandstone on plinth; pantile roof with brick stacks to cottages; slate roof to stable building. 2 low storey, 9-window front. 4 replacement board doors and 2-light, small-pane window throughout except for those to end left which are inserted large-pane casements. Whitewashed flat arches to original openings. To centre are 2 round-arched niches, the lower one containing a cast-iron pump, the upper one blank. Stepped eaves course. Gable wall to right contains a Victorian letterbox. Roof to left gable end is coped, with shaped kneeler, and carries one end of a wrought-iron overthrow and lamp bracket linked to Whitewall House (qv). 5 ridge stacks. Included for group value.
